GSG Optional Girls Teams Start Strong & Win GOLD!

On January 10-12th our Girls Artistic Team competed in the Judge's Cup in Santa Clara and had a phenomenal start to their season.

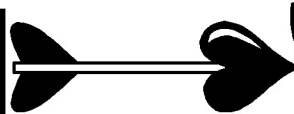
Our XCel Diamond WON their division! Rebecca led the team tying for second on Vault and winning bronze on Beam. Kaylee stuck a silver medal on Beam and Sofi danced into a 9.05 on Floor. Noor competed in the Silver Division and won GOLD on Vault with a 9.3, and tied for silver on Bars. Janna and Maya competed in the Gold Division and both had their strongest finish on Bars, with Janna winning a silver medal with a 9.25, and Maya swinging into the top ten. Competing in the Platinum Division, Victoria led the team sticking her Beam routine and taking home a silver medal, and two bronzes on Vault with a 9.175, and Floor with a 9.3. Amanda, Dana, Natalie, and Teresa all scored in the nines on Floor. Amanda earned a 9.175, Dana a 9.125, Natalie a 9.025, and Teresa a 9.0. Shelby grabbed her 9.05 on Bars. Jillian, Poppy, Anika all flew into the top eight on Vault, and Katie Hasser swung into the top five on Bars.

For the JO Levels, Naima in Level 6 won GOLD on Floor with a 9.45, silver on Beam with a 9.1, then completed her medal set with bronze in All-Around. In her age division Luna also danced into GOLD on Floor with a 9.425. Abby won FIRST on Vault. Ananya took home a silver All-Around and bronze on Vault. Libby and Sofia both scored a 9.25 on Floor in two different age groups, Libby finished in third and Sofia in fourth. The Level 7's continued Gold Star's dominance on Floor with Sylvia scoring a 9.475 and winning silver. Catherine, Millie, and Marlys all landed in the top ten on Floor and all earned 9's - Catherine a 9.325, Millie a 9.1, and Marlys a 9.0. Emi grabbed two silver medals, on Bars and All-Around. The Level 8's were led by Vanessa who WON gold on Bars with a 9.55, and earned two bronzes on Vault and All-Around. The 8's also showed their floor prowess with Jacqui and Phoebe tying for second with a 9.1. Phoebe ran away with a bronze on Vault, alongside Courtney, who had her strongest finish on Vault. In Level 9 Mimi earned two bronze medals on Floor with a 9.325, and Bars. Anne continued GSG's floor expertise scoring a 9.0. Kelly finished in the top six in her session on Vault and Beam. And our Level 10's were exceptional with Kendra winning GOLD on Bars with a 9.1 and Laura ending the day with a bronze All-Around.
